The official national call announcement for Australia has been distributed within CSIRO along with details of the call and the application process.

Interested CSIRO researchers are advised to contact the National Contact Point before starting to prepare proposals for application or contacting potential collaborators in other countries to express their interest in participating in proposals. CSIRO researchers may also seek to include collaborators from other Australian research organisations.

Eligibility and national funding modalities:

- The Australian element of any proposal will comprise in-kind (i.e. non-cash) research commitment only, with each participating Australian research organisation responsible for meeting its own costs of participation in the call and any successful trans-national collaboration arising from the call, although supplementary funding from external sources may be sought if agreed by CSIRO and the other participating Australian research organisations.
- The Australian element of any proposal must include both natural and social/economic scientists addressing integrated natural-socio/economic research challenges.
- In line with the Belmont Forum aims of leveraging members commitments CSIRO will only support scientific activities that demonstrably build upon its investments and strategy (please contact the National Contact Point to confirm your eligibility):
