- Researchers from at least two Nordic countries, including the autonomous areas Greenland, Åland or the Faroe Island, must be part of the consortium
- The project applied for must seek synergies with the joint Nordic Initiative on Arctic Research: “Responsible Development of the Arctic – Opportunities and Challenges – Pathways to Action”, see the annexed programme memorandum.
- The application must include a brief ethical statement and a statement on how gender issues will be handled in the project.
