Eligibility and national funding modalities:

Swedish applicants may apply for a maximum of 3 million SEK (approx. 300 k€) for participation in a project and a maximum of 4 million SEK (approx. 400 k€) if the applicant also is coordinating the project as Leading Principal Investigator. Project duration is 3 years, with a possible no-cost extension for one extra year.
