#### **Eligibility and national funding modalities:**

The total maximum contribution from Formas per application (for one or more Swedish partners) is 3 million SEK (approx. 300 k€) for participation in a project or a maximum of 4 million SEK (approx. 400 k€) if the applicant is coordinating the project as Leading Principal Investigator. Swedish applicants in a consortium are encouraged to apply to Formas under one single PI. Project duration is 3 years, with a possible no-cost extension for one extra year.
