## Eligibility and national funding modalities:

This call is open to researchers and practitioners in Nigerian universities, research institutions and non-governmental or community-based organizations. Applications should seek to align their research projects with the Belmont CRA. Applicants will be required to meet the specific eligibility criteria as spelt out in the call. All applications will be assessed on the basis of these eligibility criteria as well as the selection criteria described in the call.
